# Joshua 4:1-7

Joshua 4:1-7

[1] When all the nation had finished passing over the Jordan, the LORD said to Joshua, [2] “Take twelve men from the people, from each tribe a man, [3] and command them, saying, ‘Take twelve stones from here out of the midst of the Jordan, from the very place where the priests’ feet stood firmly, and bring them over with you and lay them down in the place where you lodge tonight.’” [4] Then Joshua called the twelve men from the people of Israel, whom he had appointed, a man from each tribe. [5] And Joshua said to them, “Pass on before the ark of the LORD your God into the midst of the Jordan, and take up each of you a stone upon his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the people of Israel, [6] that this may be a sign among you. When your children ask in time to come, ‘What do those stones mean to you?’ [7] then you shall tell them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD. When it passed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. So these stones shall be to the people of Israel a memorial forever.” (ESV)

## Reflection Questions:

1. Where in your life right now are you standing at the edge of the Jordan — sensing God’s call but hesitating to step in? What is one concrete act of obedience you’ve been putting off until conditions feel safer?
2. When difficulty comes, does your instinct lead you toward worship or away from it? Where is worship in terms of priority in your life right now?
3. What stones of remembrance are you building for the people coming after you — your children, younger believers, or those not yet in the faith? Is there someone in your life who needs to see how you live more than they need to hear what you believe?
