A word from Pastor Justin

Dear Friends in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in this Easter season!

Easter is more than a single Sunday, it is a season of **resurrection, renewal, and new life**. We continue to celebrate that Christ is risen, and because He is risen, we are invited into a life that is continually being made new. This is not only something we remember, it is something we live. The same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead is still at work among us, breathing fresh life into our congregation and guiding us forward. Over the past few weeks, I have been especially mindful of the work of the Holy Spirit in our life together. At our recent council retreat, your church leaders gathered not simply to plan or strategize, but to listen and prayerfully discern where we believe the Holy Spirit is leading Mt. Pisgah over the next 3-5 years. It was a meaningful and hope-filled time as we reflected on who we are, where we have been, and where God might be calling us next.

During the Easter season, many of our readings come from the book of Acts, where we see the early church doing this very same work of discernment. In Acts 2:42, we are told that the believers devoted themselves to teaching, fellowship, breaking bread, and prayer. The Greek word used for “fellowship” is *koinonia*; **meaning a deep, spiritual connection marked by participation, shared life, and unity**. It was the Holy Spirit that brought them together and propelled them outward to serve God’s kingdom.

That same Spirit is alive and active here at Mt. Pisgah.

As we begin this season of discernment as a congregation, I invite you to reflect on this question: ***Where is the Holy Spirit already moving... and how do we get to join in?*** God’s kingdom is never finished, and each of us has a role to play in what God is doing next. This is not just work for a council or a committee, it is a calling for the whole body of Christ. In the months ahead, our council will continue to listen, pray, and discern together. I truly believe this will be a time of growth, renewal, and shared purpose.

What a gift it is to be part of a church that is open to the Spirit’s leading! What a joy it is to step into the unknown with faith, trusting that God is already at work ahead of us. I am excited to see where the Holy Spirit leads us next.

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!

Income for January through March was \$101,228, which is 89% of budget. Income for January and February were below budget partly due to the snow and ice storms that cancelled services. Income in March was over budget, which helped make up some for January and February being low. Expenses for January through March were \$113,062, which is 99% of budget. So, for January through March, we spent \$11,834 more than we received. Income was up in March, which is great. Hopefully, income will stay up the rest of the fiscal year. We also have \$163,059 in the reserve account as of March 31st. We are in good shape financially at this point in the year.
