Glory Carriers

Exodus 34:29-35 ESV “When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God. Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him. But Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the leaders of the congregation returned to him, and Moses talked with them. Afterward all the people of Israel came near, and he commanded them all that the Lord had spoken with him in Mount Sinai. And when Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face. Whenever Moses went in before the Lord to speak with him, he would remove the veil, until he came out. And when he came out and told the people of Israel what he was commanded, the people of Israel would see the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses’ face was shining. And Moses would put the veil over his face again, until he went in to speak with him.”

- After spending 40 days on Mount Sinai with God, Moses is sent back down the mountain with a renewed covenant, clear instructions, and Divine direction. However, unbeknownst to him, Moses’s entire continent had changed due to the fact that he spent concentrated time in the presence of the Lord. In essence, making him a **glory carrier**
- **Glory carriers are believers in Christ who consciously host, embody, and radiate the manifest presence, power, and character of God in their daily lives. As walking temples of the Holy Spirit, they are considered vessels that bring a heavenly atmosphere to earth, change spiritual dynamics, and bring healing or refreshing to those around them.**
- **The glory that’s on your life is not there for you to be glorified. It’s there for people to see God’s goodness and glorify HIM! (Matthew 5:16)**
- **The glory that’s on your life has eternal significance. (Jude 1:9)**
