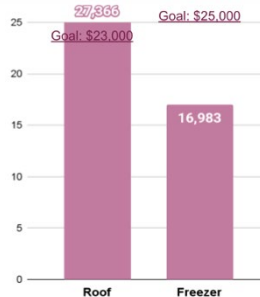

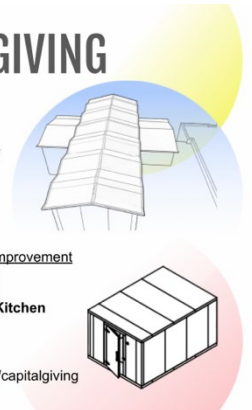

While in the area, you can visit buildings at the Lutheran Heritage Center and Museum in nearby Altenburg, Missouri. However, the host Zones (Altenburg, Cape Girardeau, Iron Mountain, and Jackson Bootheel) have planned numerous convention activities including Friday night's Worship service, Mission Walk, Mission Fair and Silent Auction. CALVARY COMMITMENT

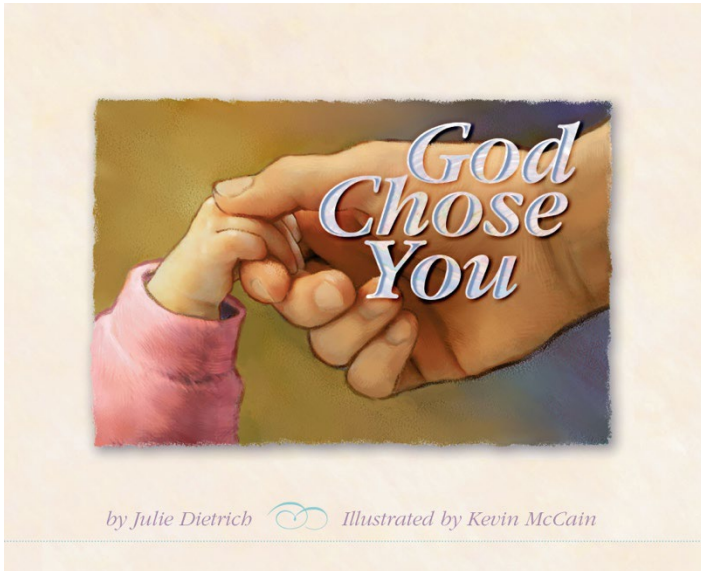

Reading Reinforcement



The past few weeks, we have focused on the celebration of Baptism. As we wrap up this theme, we want to take a look at a small resource with a big impact.

In 2000, Concordia Publishing House released a small hardcover book entitled *God Chose You* by Julie Dietrich. Written in rhyme, the pages of *God Chose You* remind the reader of God's plan for His children as they enter His kingdom through the waters of Holy Baptism.

Each page of text is paired with beautiful illustrations rendered by artist Kevin McCain with an almost photographic appearance.

Every Day, Special Days

The images portray parents cradling their infants, bringing their child to the waters of Baptism, or walking together as a family. These endearing illustrations complete the text rather than compete with it. The compact size of *God Chose You* makes it easy to tuck into your diaper bag or church busy bag to review before the service. If you witness a Baptism at church on Sunday, take time to review memories of your child's Baptism as you read through the pages of *God Chose You* once again.

When you celebrate family Baptism birthdays, consider reading *God Chose You* as part of your celebration. For younger children, parents can read aloud. Older children who read independently could read aloud all or portions of the book for the rest of your family.


Building Bedtime Routines

Many parents enjoy reading the endearing rhymes of *God Chose You* as part of the bedtime routine with their little ones. What a great way to close the day and prepare your children for a peaceful night's sleep than to remind them of God's promised love and protection
