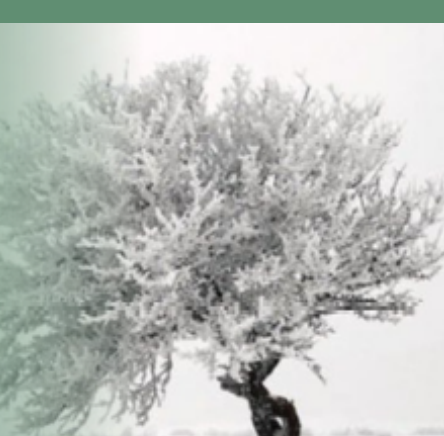
Kids at Summer Camp
