Please note our regular Sunday gathering will be cancelled that morning as "The Church" has left the building.

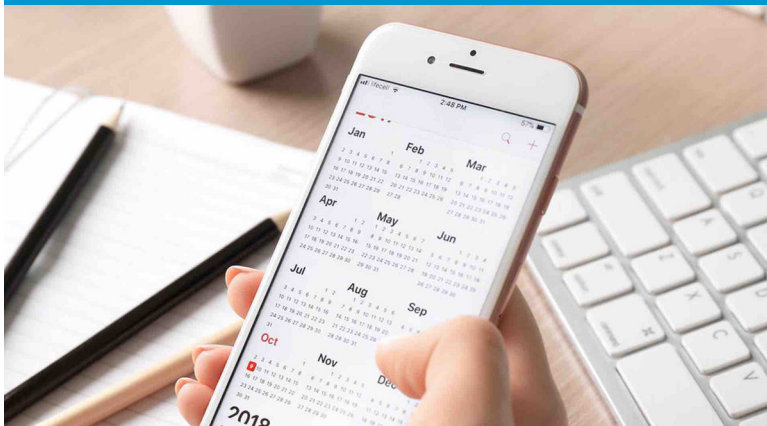

Jesus said “A new command I give you: “...Love one another. In the same way I loved you, you love one another. This is how everyone will recognize that you are my disciples—when they see the love you have for each other.” John 13 verse 34
