I will be working to get all accounts current before my last day in the school office.

**As a reminder to 8th grade parents, your account must be in good standing at the time of graduation. Records will not be sent to the high school that your child is moving on to.*

**3rd and 4th grade families, you may want to check your lunch account balance since they are allowed to order an extra entrée daily.*

**As we get closer to the end of school, your account must have a zero or credit balance. \$32 will cover lunches until the end of the school year. That amount does not include any current balance, extra milk or extra entrée. For any families that are not returning in the fall, if you have a credit, refunds will be issued in June after all final payments have been posted.*

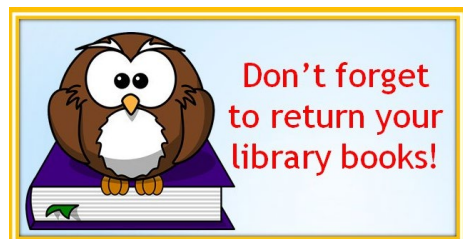
Medication Pick Up Reminder!

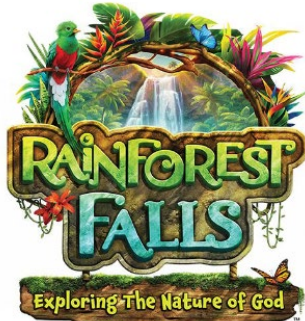

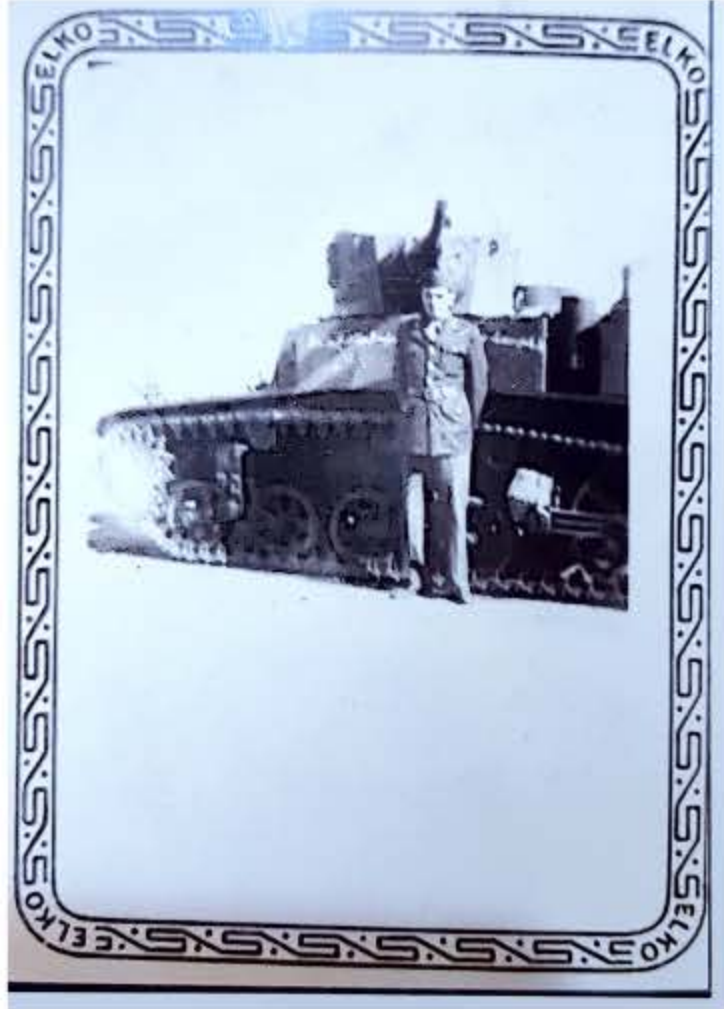
