Week 4 - Acts 2:14-41

Read Acts 2:14-41. What is the first thing that stands out to you?

What stands out to you about what happens at Pentecost? What do these signs seem to reveal about the Holy Spirit?

What does it mean to you personally that we now have direct access to God through the Holy Spirit? Do you tend to live like you have that access or does God feel distant?

As referenced in the sermon, wind (gentle or violent) and fire (destroy or purify) can be imagery for the nature of the Holy Spirit. Have you seen God work in your life in those ways?

What do you think had the biggest impact on Peter's life to bring him to the point we see hear his first sermon in Acts 2?

The people in Acts 2 were "cut to the heart." Have you ever experienced a time a conviction like that from the Holy Spirit?

What is the Holy Spirit calling you to do at this time, and how might the Holy Spirit empower you to do it? Take time to pray together for sensitivity to the Spirit's calling, courage to follow, and for faith that Holy Spirit will empower.
