**“There is no need to hold it together yourself when Christ has already provided everything you need to stand unafraid in this world of chaos.”**

---

### SERMON OUTLINE

#### I. He Provided a \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 26)

The Spirit is not an influence — He is a \_\_\_\_\_.

He \_\_\_\_\_ all things Christ has spoken.

He brings to \_\_\_\_\_ at precisely the moment it is needed.

#### II. He Provided a \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 27a–b)

World's peace: \_\_\_\_\_ (holds only when conditions cooperate).

Christ's peace: \_\_\_\_\_ (holds precisely when they do not).

'I \_\_\_\_\_ with you' / 'I \_\_\_\_\_ unto you'

#### III. He Provided a \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 27c)

'Troubled' = agitation from \_\_\_\_\_ (passive voice).

'Afraid' = the heart's own \_\_\_\_\_ (active voice).

This command appears \_\_\_\_\_ times in John 14 (v. 1 and v. 27).

### SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION

John 14:25–27 — The Guide for the Journey

---

**Q1.** Jesus says ‘being yet present with you.’ What does the word ‘yet’ imply is coming? What is the emotional weight of that word for the disciples?

**Q2.** The sermon distinguished the Holy Spirit as a person rather than an influence. What changes practically if He is a person who shows up, knows your name, and stays?

**Q3.** Jesus uses two words for giving peace: ‘I leave’ and ‘I give.’ Why two? What does each add that the other does not?

**Q4.** ‘Troubled’ is passive — done to the heart from without. ‘Afraid’ is active — the heart’s own retreat. Have you experienced both? Which is closer to where you are right now?

**Q5.** What is one concrete thing you will do this week to stand on what He has provided rather than reach for the world’s peace?

#### Memory Verse:

“Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.” — John 14:27b (KJV)

---

Close in prayer. Pray by name for what was shared. Ask God to make the Big Idea real in each person’s upper room this week.
