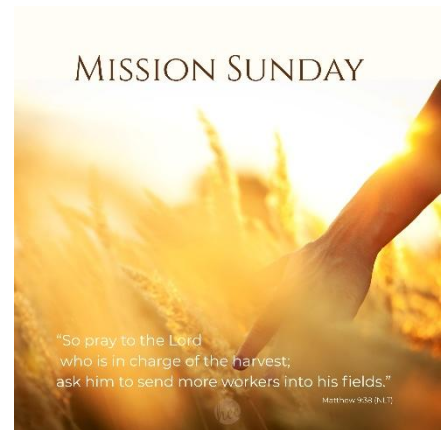


Life Group Study Notes

Consider the following prayer points from the different missions we support...and then let's pray:

International Justice Mission / Salvation Army: Anti-human trafficking (Peter & Tammy Williams)

- Peace and freedom as they live in Kuala Lumpur Malaysia where the state religion is Islam
- Tammy as she juggles work (20 hours weekly) and childcare, especially Ellie (2).
- Travel mercies for Pete as he visits 8 Asian countries. (Mon-Fri every second week)
- Freedom for victims of human trafficking, especially in Myanmar and Cambodia.
- Obtain a Nomad Digital Visa for Tammy to get paid in-country.
- Brooke (11) as she studies at the Australian International School: Good teachers and friends
- Forge new relationships in their new home church of Holy Trinity Brompton (KL).

Alongsiders / Asia Freedom Network (Craig & Nay Greenfield)

- Repatriation of 300 liberated cyber-scam trafficking victims from one compound
- Physical and psychological healing for those who have been tortured
- Liberation of victims from the many other compounds
- Wisdom for Nay; that she would find favour with officials of Government and other agencies
- Shalom Valley: Spiritual blessing for the women who recently attended the camp; discipleship for the 12 who were baptised
- Reach the goal of 300 'Gideon torch bearer' donors
- Continued impact on vulnerable children in 33 countries
- Vision for the future; "pivoting" as God shows the way
- Consider legacy giving as Maurice Brown did

Mission Aviation Fellowship (Phil and Tania Sproul)

- The team in Madagascar can continue to be self-sustaining
- Greater openings for distribution of aid in New Guinea
- Blessing for the teams operating in Chad and South Sudan
- Peace and protection in conflict areas where populations have been displaced
- Wisdom in prioritising the use of limited resources
- Bless the Sproul's move to Christchurch in June

Sowers Trust (Wayne, George, Lucky, IJE, the trustees and others who support)

- Enable the team to adapt & adjust to the needs of each person they encounter
- That the team can create a space that is safe and non-judgemental
- That they can be a light in the darkness as they walk with young people for a season
- Plant seeds of hope as they go out into homes, the streets and schools
- God's presence will help them supernaturally
- Function out of God's wisdom so that the youth will run towards them, not away from them
