We would like to share that we are still in our season of home assignment, though it is quickly coming to an end next month! This has been a busy time for us, with many responsibilities, as it truly is a different kind of assignment—even while we are in our home country.

We are deeply grateful for the many sweet and blessed things the Lord has allowed us to experience during this time. Wellington married Nicole, Pastor William’s daughter. He is our childhood friend and the one who officiated our wedding! Wellington also married Armando, who, as a child, was Tati’s English student at Restoration Ministries, and over the years our families have become close friends. We were also able to celebrate all four of our children’s birthdays together, with all their siblings and grandparents present. We reconnected with our brothers and sisters at Restoration Ministries, joining some of their programs. We also had a joy of hosting and spending time with two dear American families.

In the meantime, we are keeping in touch with Mozambique, and ministry continues at full pace there. Pastor Daudi, his wife Berta, and our missionary partner Robert are faithfully caring for and serving people in Lumbo. Preschool classes started in February, the chicken selling business is operating, some of the teens joined as helpers at the children’s Bible program, Pastor Daudi is starting baptism classes soon, youth encounters are happening periodically, and our team is getting ready for the Samaritan’s Purse outreach for 480 kids in four different sites!
