## A Do-Over

### I. The Strategy (1-9)

1. Read Joshua 8:1-9. What difference do you see in the second plan to attack Ai from the first plan (7:2-3)?

What difference do you see in this plan to the plan to attack Jericho (6:2-5)?

What lesson do you see about making plans to do what you believe God wants you to do? Describe how you would do what the lesson says.

2. Read the account of the execution of the battle plan in Joshua 8:10-29. Joshua had not only gotten the plan from the Lord, but he had also gotten directions from the Lord during the battle. How would you make provision for God to direct you during the busyness of carrying out your ministry plan?

3. From Joshua 8:30-35, what did Joshua and Israel do after the victory? What stands out in this account?

Describe how you could show the same response to God after He gives you victory in the ministry He has given you.

4. Make an application to disciple-making from the principles seen in this account in Israel's history.
