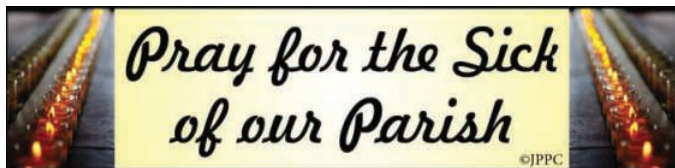


OUR SACRED PURPOSE

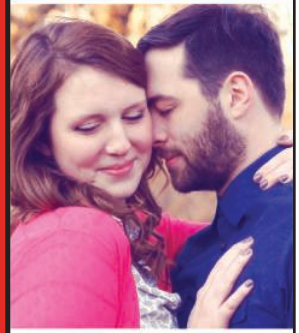
