Week 5 - Acts 2:42-47

Read Acts 2:42-41. What do you notice about God? What stands out to you most about the picture of the early church in this passage?

When you hear the word *devoted*, what's the first thing that comes to mind? What's something you see people being devoted to today? If someone observed your daily life, what would they say you are most devoted to?

What do you think most people today believe defines a Christian? Why is it easy for Christianity to become more about cultural positions than becoming like Jesus?

If the early believers had to navigate being formed by Rome or by Jesus, what would you say we as 21-Century believers face? What is our “Rome”? In what ways does culture try and form our values, priorities, and identity?

If you're honest, what or whom are you a disciple of right now? What would need to change in your life for devotion to Jesus to become more central than anything else?

Pastor Dan shared four practices to engage with that help us be formed more to be like Jesus: 1) reading the Word, 2) daily prayer, 3) share a meal, 4) start/join a small Group. Which one of these is God inviting you to intentionally step into this week?

Take time to pray for one another and pray specifically for the power of God to help you stand against the things that are forming you that are not Jesus.
