Our Spring congregational meeting is to be held on May 17th directly after worship, and at this time, the FY2026 budget recommendations are to be discussed and voted

Nominations continue to be finalized for working groups and leadership roles as well, and several of you are still considering how to respond. Thank you (and here's to "yesses")! Information will be reviewed prior to the meeting as per the standard required in our Constitution & By Laws, and any questions can be directed to me or our Moderator, Matt, or other Council members.

The Generosity Campaign, "Making All Things New," which so many of you have been willing to make commitments to with pledges and gifts is now winding down. Under the leadership of Don Pope and his team (Jared Cazel, Michelle Ucciferri and Heather McGoldrick), an amazing total of \$233,158 has been offered toward our goal of \$250,000. Finally, the excitement is building for special presentations and events of the Spring and Summer, including time with Howard Krajel about his bike pilgrimage to Spain (May 31<sup>st</sup> after worship) and an upcoming summer worship series. Your conversations during our March community "café" conversations have provided galvanizing feedback that we will look to explore further. I give thanks for the ambitions and growing interests of our spiritual community – be on the lookout for surveys about starting a new book group and your experiences during Lent!

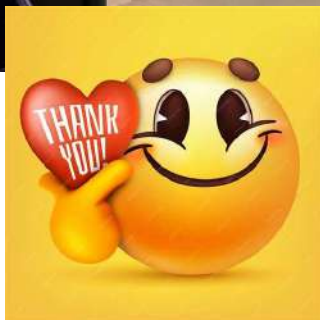
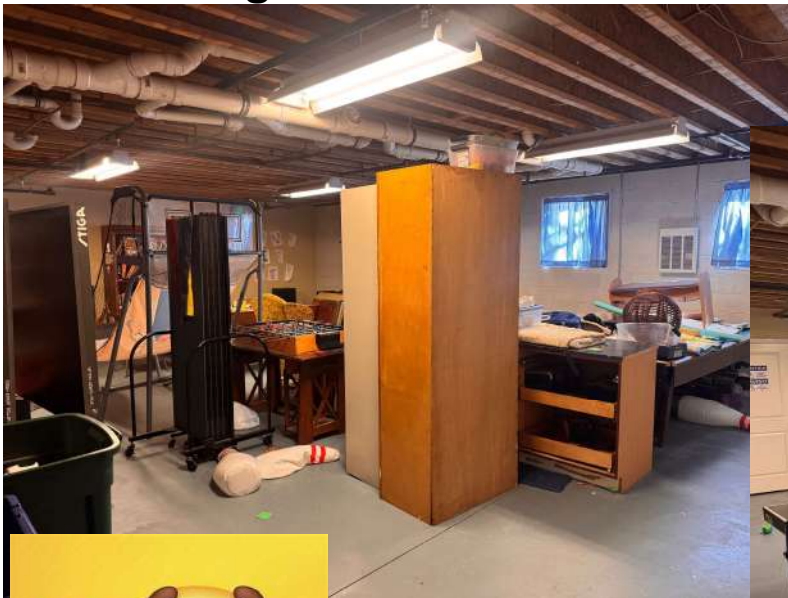
