## WITH CARDS AND LETTERS

In conjunction with our country's 250th anniversary – and for giving thanks to all those who are serving in the military and their families – we are collecting cards and letters of support.

If you would like to participate, get a “thank you” card of your choice and complete it according to the suggestions noted below. Place your cards and letters of encouragement and thanks in the colorfully decorated boxes with American flags available in the main entries between May 24 and July 5.

The cards will be forwarded to Support Our Troops (SOT), an entity with offices in Daytona Beach, FL and Ayden, NC. SOT will forward your cards and letters to the troops.

SOT has very strict guidelines to follow. It is not possible to write directly to or be a direct pen pal with a deployed soldier. Here are some writing tips:

- **Be positive.** They are meant to uplift and encourage.
- **Be thankful.** Be sure to communicate your appreciation for the soldiers’ sacrifices and dedication to us and our country.
- **Be respectful.** These women and men have earned it more than most of us!
- **Be kind and encouraging.** Remember most of us have never and will probably never have to endure the difficulties that these soldiers have experienced.
- Specifically, please **DO NOT** include your email, phone number, or mailing address. Do not include a stamp or return address label and do not put cash or any other gifts inside the envelope. **DO NOT** use your last name. Leave the cards unsealed for inspection by SOT, or they won’t be sent.

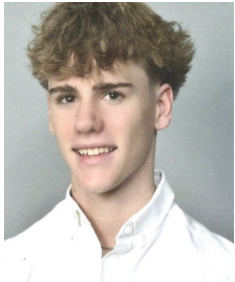

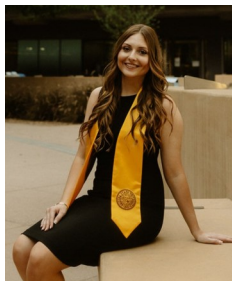
