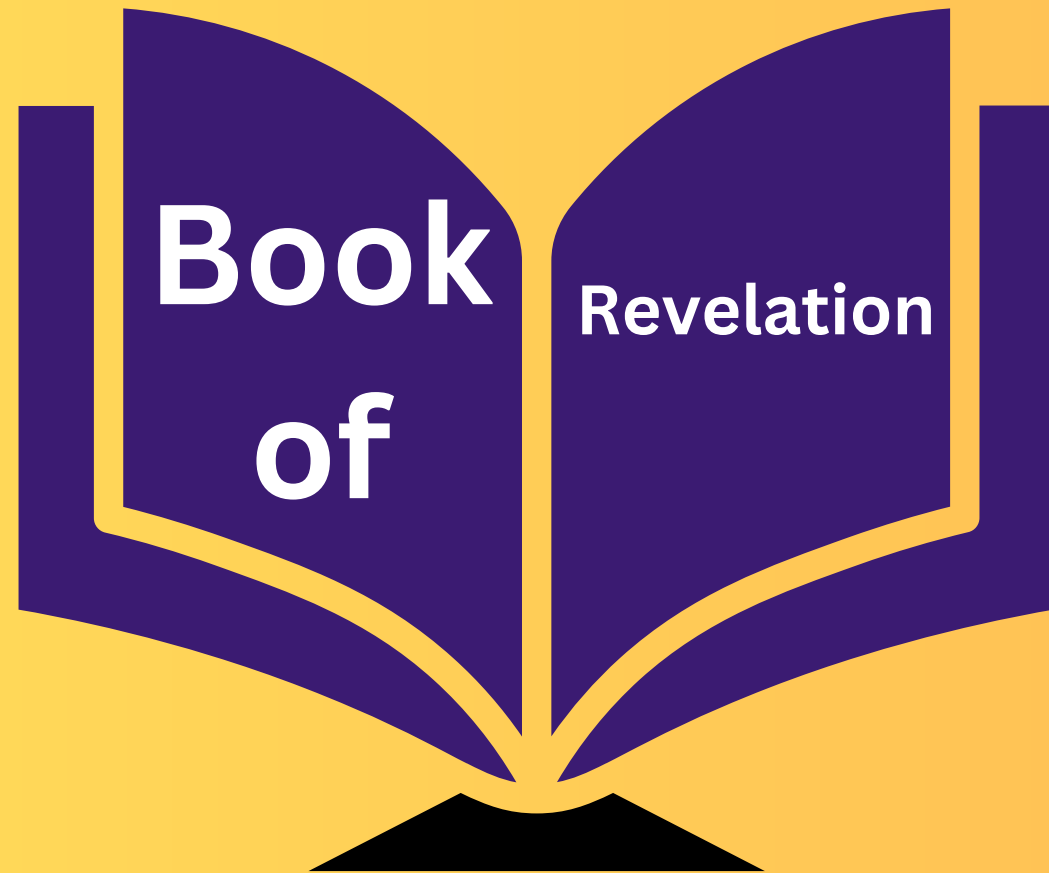
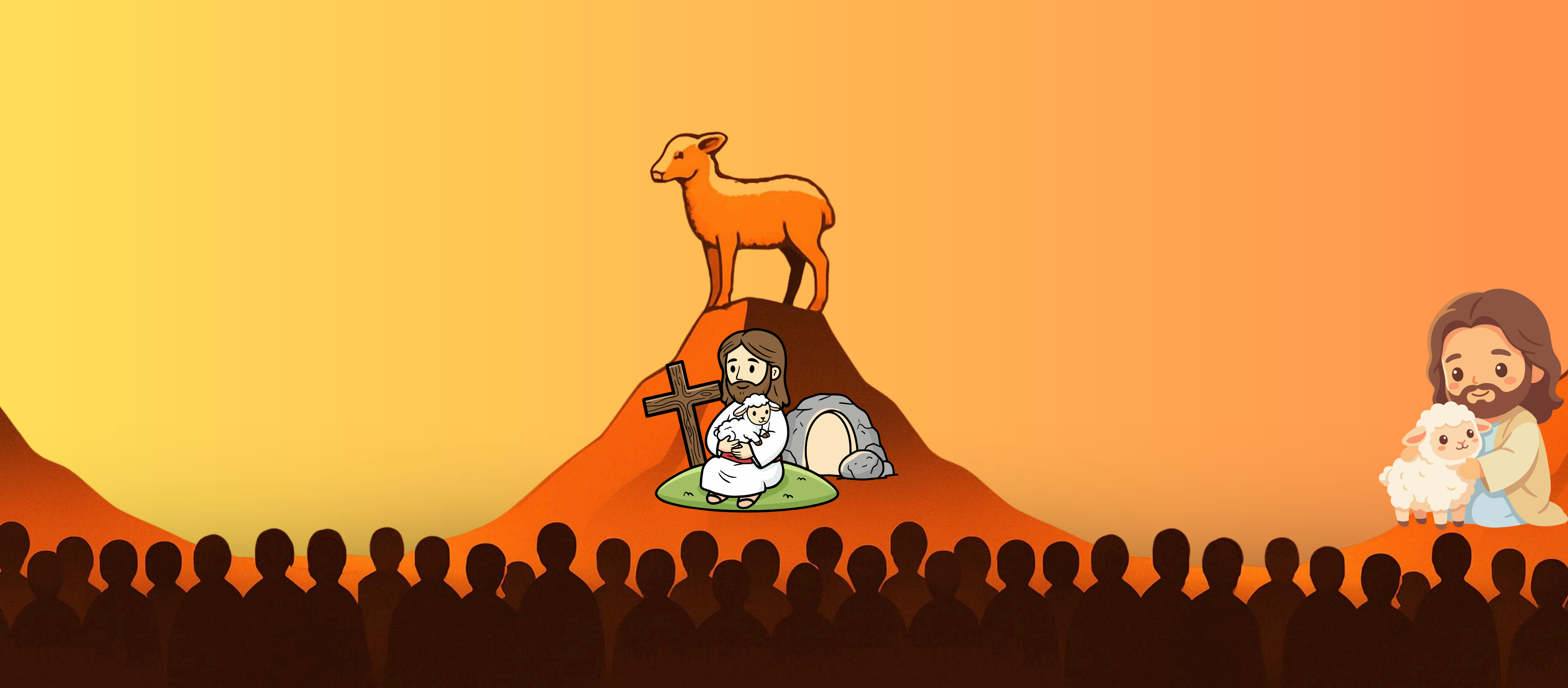


Revelation Chapter 14

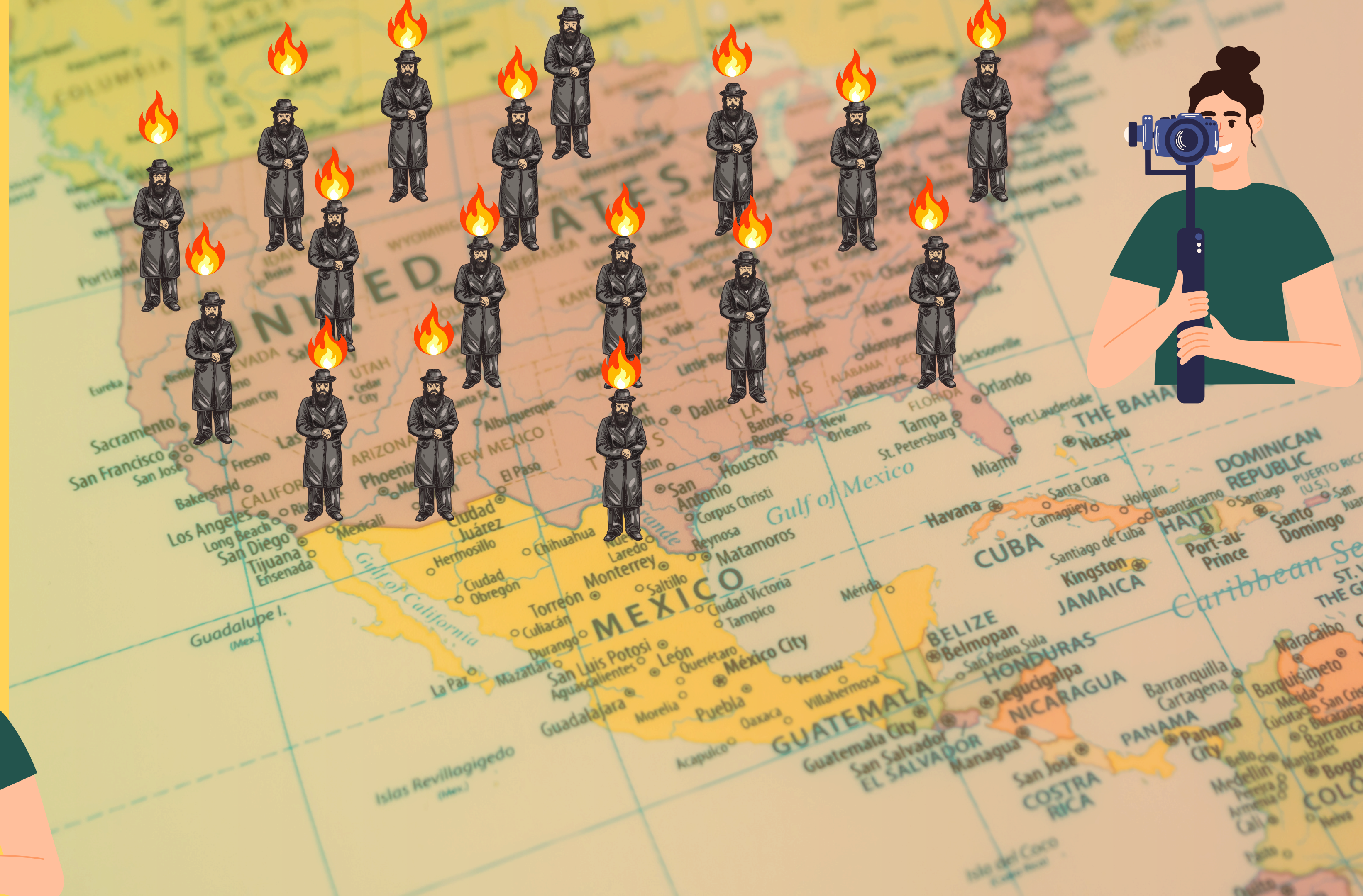
