Join us for the upcoming IBCD Summer Institute, a three-day conference designed to equip and encourage local churches in biblical counseling. This event brings together believers from around the world for inspiring sessions, practical workshops, and valuable resources to help strengthen discipleship ministry within the church. Why the Summer Institute?

At IBCD, [we're passionate about caring for the local church](#), especially in the Los Angeles region. Our goal for the conference is to connect people with a breadth and depth of counseling education and resources so that the Church is better equipped to minister. It's a great place to meet like-minded biblical counselors and those wanting to grow in one-another care.

What is it like?

Our 3-day conference draws around 500 attendees from across the world and is hosted at a local church, Cornerstone Fellowship Bible Church (also online). We lead several main sessions covering the event theme, and over 30 different workshops by various speakers on relevant discipleship topics. We're excited to even be hosting a few workshops in Spanish this year. Our Exhibitor Hall will feature over a dozen different ministries, a huge biblical counseling bookstore, an on-site coffee shop, and more!
