**“DISCIPLES BY DESIGN: COMMITTED FEET”**

*Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, <sup>15</sup>and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. (Ephesians 6:14-15)*

**1. GOD SECURES OUR FEET IN HIS \_\_\_\_\_.**

**A. WE WALK IN THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF GOD’S WORD.**

*Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.  
(Psalm 119:105)*

**MEMORY VERSE**

*But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.  
(1 John 1:7)*

**B. WE WALK IN HIS \_\_\_\_\_.**

*And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it. (2 John 1:6)*

**C. GOD EMPOWERS US TO \_\_\_\_\_ HUMBLY.**

He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? (Micah 6:8)

*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” (Matthew 28:19-20)*

*How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?<sup>15</sup> And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!” (Romans 10:14-15)*

**B. WE CARRY THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF THE WORLD.**

*Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” (John 8:12)*
