The Family Altar

The Family Altar time is so vital. I recommend a specific time, morning or evening, that the family gathers for the purpose of prayer and Bible reading.

This can be anywhere from 5 to 15 minutes or longer. Select a passage of scripture and read it as a family.

Different ones in the family could take turns reading a Bible verse or two, or Dad could read the whole passage, or Mom, if she is the one having to lead it. After scripture reading, take time for some prayer requests and then pray together as a family.

One can pray, or many can pray. Make sure the very next day it gets started again. Make sure during this time the television and phones are off. Get rid of distractions. Require attention.

Make the family altar a time for love, joy, and memories. You can even take a portion of the Family Altar time and read a book in sections. This could be a life story of a missionary or preacher. Make sure it is a book that will build a spiritual character. May the Lord bless your Family Altar.
