Week 6 - Acts 3:1-4:4

Can you think of a time you felt you deserved recognition but didn't get it? How did it make you feel?

The sermon described "main character culture" which is the pressure to be seen, noticed, and affirmed. Where do you see this most in your own life? At work, on social media, in relationships?

Peter could have taken all the credit after healing the lame man, but he immediately redirected attention to Jesus. What makes that so hard to do in our own moments of success or praise?

The sermon makes the point that the church can fall into the trap of thinking more resources equals more kingdom impact. Do you agree? Where have you seen this play out, for better or worse?

Peter says "what I have I give you" which means the Spirit, not silver or gold. What do you think it looks like practically to be generous with the Spirit in your everyday life?

The sermon ends with three practices: humility, confession, and celebrating others. Which of those three is hardest for you, and why?

Where in your life right now might God be asking you to "get out of the way" so he has more room to work?

Take time to pray with one another.
