This school year, Daniel was again able to find a school where he could run a basketball program. Each Monday afternoon, around 20 teens would come and learn more about basketball. The two hours of drills and game play not only helped them improve their basketball skills, but it also helped build relationships. A handful of the teens already attended youth group on Friday afternoons, but over the course of the year, more teens from basketball also began coming out to youth group.

This year we have seen the youth group grow tremendously. Daniel taught on how to live their lives like David, who was a man after God's own heart. Each lesson challenged and encouraged them in different areas of their lives. In February, Daniel split the teens up into three teams and began a two-month competition with them. They were encouraged to bring friends, learn Bible verses, and work together as a team. At the end of the competition, the winning team won a trip to Chisinau, to a special team building challenge and a pizza party afterwards. The teens worked hard, but one team, in particular, brought over 10 first time visitors. **Please continue to pray for each of these teens.** Some have made professions of faith, but all have heard the Gospel numerous times.
