THE FREEDOM OF FORGIVENESS

Many of us carry the emotional weight of unforgiveness, stemming from past betrayal, family wounds, church hurt, broken trust, harsh words, or deep disappointment.

God calls forgiven people to be forgiving people.

Colossians 1:9-14

⁹ For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding, ¹⁰ so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, ¹¹ being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, ¹² and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light. ¹³ For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Forgiveness begins with spiritual wisdom and understanding.
