God's Love for Real

There is a kind of love the world knows well, the love that depends on performance, that measures its affection by worthiness, that withdraws when the object of its devotion fails to measure up. It is a love built on conditions, a fragile thing that evaporates the moment the beloved disappoints. We have all known this love in some measure, and if we are honest, we have all practiced it too. But the love of God is not this kind of love. It is something real, something rugged, something that reaches down into the very worst of who we are and refuses to let go.

The apostle John puts it with simplicity: "God is love" (1 John 4:8). Not that God merely loves, though He does. Not that God is loving, though He is. John goes further. Love is not simply something God does, it is who He is. It is His very nature, His essence, the atmosphere of His being. And because God is love, every act of God flows from a heart that seeks the benefit of others. Even before the world was made, there was love between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit (John 17:24). Love did not begin with us. It began in eternity. We are not the origin of God's love, we are the overflow of it.

But if God's love is eternal, it is also historic. It entered time and space in the most unimaginable way. "In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him" (1 John 4:9). Love, real love, does not stay safely in the realm of sentiment. It acts. It moves. It sends. God did not love us from a distance. He loved us with arms outstretched on a Roman cross.

So, what does it mean for us, to know that God's love is real? It means first that we can stop trying to earn what has already been freely given. If God loved us "while we were still sinners," then there is nothing we can do to make Him love us more and nothing we can do to make Him love us less. His love is not a reward for good behavior (Ephesians 2:4-5).

It means second that we can face suffering with confidence. If neither tribulation nor distress nor persecution nor famine can separate us from God's love, then no diagnosis, no pink slip, no broken relationship, no grief can separate us either. The list in Romans 8 is not exhaustive, it is illustrative. Paul is saying that there is no circumstance, no power, no force in all the universe that can drive a wedge between the believer and the love of God.

The love of God is the most concrete reality in the universe. It has a face, the face of Jesus Christ. It has a cost, the blood of the Son of God. It has a promise, that nothing in all creation will ever separate us from it. And it has a demand, that those who have been so loved must love one another in the same way.
