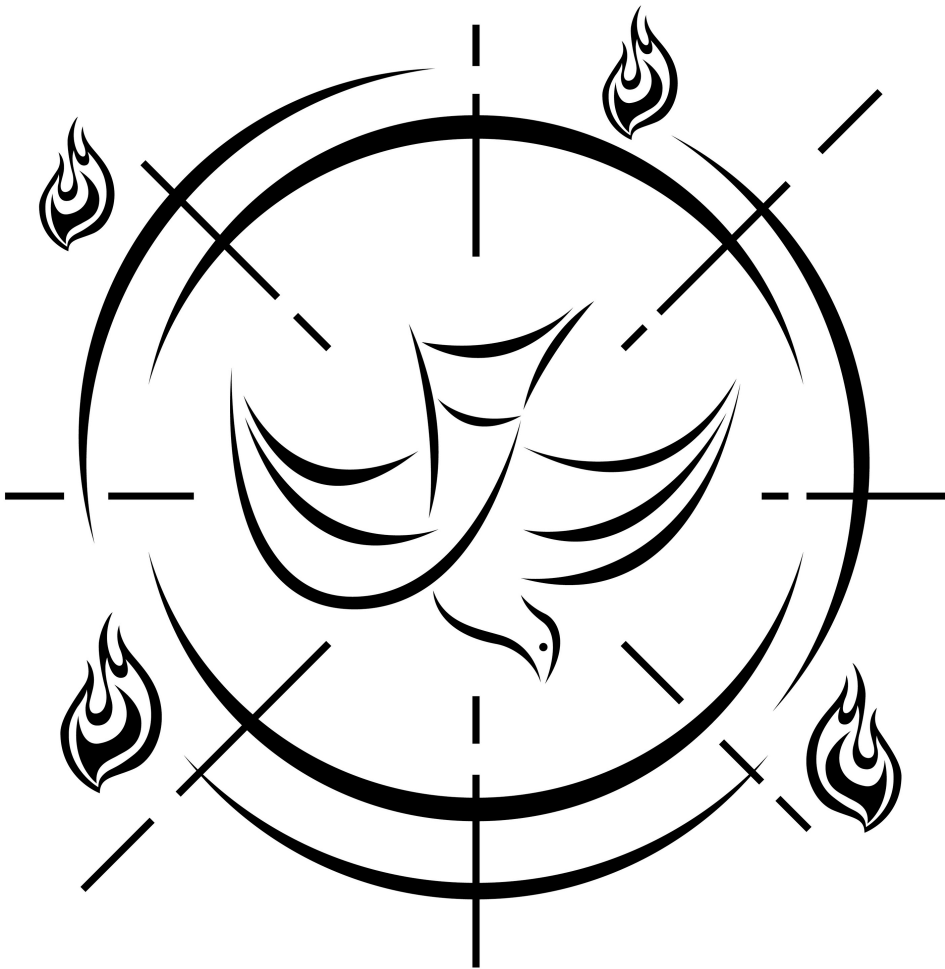


Draw & Color

Pentecost
