**Selected Scriptures**

**With God, there is no such thing as unfinished business.**

**The implication of Scripture is this: if a man just lives his life the way it's going in regard to sin, God doesn't get involved at all.**

**The Son of Man pronounces a verdict, and that verdict is based upon what \_\_\_\_\_ has done.**

**There's no miracle involved in judgment; if the man lived in sin, he'll die in sin.**

**Jesus is going to come back, first as a \_\_\_\_\_.  
Then He's going to come back as a \_\_\_\_\_.**

**The first direct \_\_\_\_\_ given in the Scriptures is about the coming of Christ in judgment.**

**It is not a surprise that Jesus comes as judge; the surprise is He came as \_\_\_\_\_.**

**In Daniel, Jesus Christ is seen as a stone who comes and smashes the world empires and takes and sets His Kingdom up, which fills the whole earth.**

**Two times heaven opens in the book of Revelation, once for the rapture and once for the second coming.**

**Jesus Christ, the conqueror is called “Faithful and True.” Why? Because He keeps His \_\_\_\_\_ and tells the \_\_\_\_\_.**

**“The Lord is a man of war.” When judgment comes, God will judge.**

**This isn’t the first time that Jesus’ robe has been stained in red.**

**What is the \_\_\_\_\_ of this judgment?**

**There was a judgment the first time He came. Only the judgment the first time was on Him.**

**Christ is going to return to reign; you can’t stop Him.**

**It isn’t in God’s nature to give a message of judgment without a message of \_\_\_\_\_. He doesn’t give judgment without giving \_\_\_\_\_.**

**God says, “Go ahead and attempt your foolishness. Try to make war with Me but I’ll set my King on His holy hill. And He’ll rule with a rod of iron, and He’ll dash rejecting men to pieces like a broken pot.” This is judgment, and the time is at the return of Jesus Christ.**
