This Sunday is designated as Trinity Sunday in the Church Calendar, and our worship will center around Paul's closing blessing in [2 Corinthians 13:11-13](#):

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you."

Often, Trinity Sunday can feel abstract or overly theological, but Paul's words remind us that the Trinity is not merely a doctrine to explain; it is the very life of God shared with us.

The heart of the Gospel is the story of God initiating a relationship with us through:

- the grace of Christ,
- the love of God,
- and the communion of the Holy Spirit.

This Sunday, we will celebrate that shared life together as we baptize both an infant and a young adult and confirm a rising seventh grader into the life of the church. These moments remind us that faith is not simply about remembering something God did long ago or hoping for something someday in the future. Faith is ongoing participation in the life of God and in the life we share together as the body of Christ.

In a world marked by isolation and division, the church is called to reflect the very nature of God, a life of love, connection, grace, and communion. Don't forget that we are gathering in one service at 10 am, as is our custom when a month contains a fifth Sunday.

I hope you will join us for this meaningful Sunday of worship and celebration.

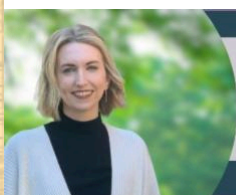
God's Guide to Financial Freedom

NTS Summer Camp /July 19-23
We're going back to NTS camp at Erskine College, in Due West, SC! This year camp will be looking into the life of David in the Old Testament and the theme is "Pursuit." We hope our students see God's pursuit of them and, in turn, become people chasing after a God who chases after us, redeems us, and prepares us for greatness. As they see themselves in this story of pursuit, we pray they walk away being known as people after God's own heart!

Registration must be completed by a parent or legal guardian over the age of 18 and is complete when all the required information is entered, and either payment is made in full, or the \$150 non-refundable/non-transferrable deposit has been made.

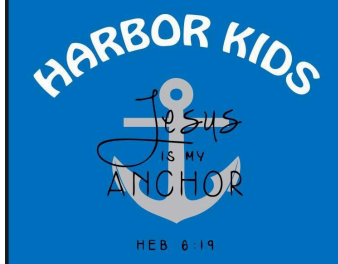
