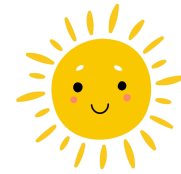
Shiloh church service began at 2 pm. There were approximately 18 in attendance at this year's service. Kane Rollins, the lay leader from Aldersgate gave the scripture and homily along with interesting history of how the Shiloh church began and what memories it held for him personally. The congregation formed shortly after the Revolutionary War and met outdoors as early as 1786 in a brush arbor. The first meeting house was made of hand-hewn logs; it burned down and the current structure was built between 1825-1830. Inman United Methodist now owns the Shiloh Church and cemetery and maintains the grounds.

As we sat in the hand-hewn pews and looked at the green pastoral setting and historical cemetery through the windows, it took us back in time. We sang "Standing on the Promises" and "Church in the Wildwood". It turned out to be a lovely day to remember how our faith grew out of such humble and important beginnings here in the Upstate. A little gem in our Inman community.
