




Discussion Questions

Psalm 70




What stood out to you in the teaching and/or in the reading of this Psalm?


Psalm 70 is a psalm of disorientation that we can pray in a season of chaos or suffering. How does this Psalm teach us to draw near in trying times?




The Anointed One has always had enemies. If you are in Christ, you are anointed with the Spirit, and you will encounter warfare in your life. Where do you feel most under attack? In certain relationships? In your work? In your thought life? How do you fight against the lies of the Enemy?



What is the connection between seeking the Lord and experiencing true joy? Where are you tempted to seek happiness?



The Psalmist desires to proclaim God's greatness because of his salvation. What is your salvation story? How have you seen God work powerfully in your past? How is He at work in your current situation?



What truths about God's character does the Psalmist declare in verse 5? Why is this important to remember in times of suffering?



What truths in this Psalm encourage your heart? Which truths challenge you?
