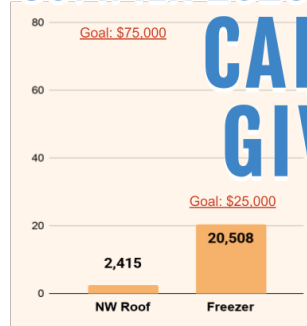

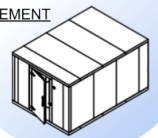

## Whisper, Whisper: Learning about Church

The *Words of Worship* program goals include identifying resources that help parents and children connect with the worship service.

This month, we are featuring *Whisper, Whisper: Learning About Church* by Mary J. Moerbe with pictures by Martha Avilés.

The rhyming verses include ideas for actions, which reinforce the words and help children understand the message. Additional tips and teaching ideas to use with your child are included at the end of the book.

### Ways to Use the Book

*Whisper, Whisper* offers opportunities for use with young children:

- Read *Whisper, Whisper* together the night before church. This book is designed to be used on Saturday evening to help children know what to expect Sunday morning. Reading it ahead of time builds familiarity with the worship routine and reduces anxiety. Curl up together and read it slowly. Point out illustrations and talk about what your child may see at church tomorrow. Ask simple questions such as, “What do you think we’ll hear the pastor say?” or “Do you remember where we sit?”
- Use the actions that accompany the verses for engagement. These actions are designed to help children focus or remember key behaviors and give you natural opportunities to practice worship habits at home. Turn each activity into a short play session. Practice whispering, sitting quietly, folding hands, or singing a simple church hymn. Role-play parts of the service in very short bursts. (Just 30–60 seconds is enough for toddlers!)
- Help your child learn the “flow” of worship. Each page’s rhyme introduces something happening at church, offering an easy way to help kids learn the order of a worship service. After reading, ask your child, “What do we do first when we get to church?” Use toy figures or stuffed animals to act out coming into the sanctuary, singing, listening, and praying.
- Make *Whisper, Whisper* part of your weekly routine. The book is meant to support families regularly, not just once. It helps establish comfort and confidence over time. The more a child sees and hears about worship at home, the more secure they feel in church. Keep *Whisper, Whisper* in a special spot, and read it weekly. Let your child carry it in their church bag after becoming familiar with it at home.

As you continue to teach your children about worship, may God bless your time together in His Word.

Council finalized their recommendation for the upcoming budget year. While the bottom-line remains the same as previously published, they chose to reduce individual board budgets by an additional \$6,000 and shift those funds to salary. This allows for funding a part-time social media position. Those changes are reflected in the attached budget. As stated last week, notable items in the budget are; filling the Associate Pastor position, increasing the base pay rate for staff and funding years of service raises. Items that we must address in future years are personnel salaries to get us closer to the Missouri District's recommended pay rates and planning for large capital expenditures. (Additional roof replacements, HVAC unit replacements, flooring replacements, parking lot paving, etc.) We have made a lot of progress on the building, but we know additional work remains to be accomplished.

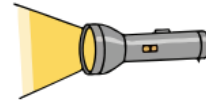

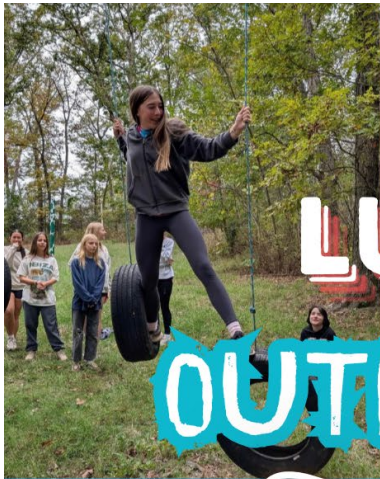

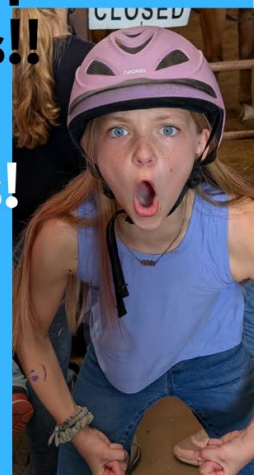
