Month of June Topic

The Expectation Gap by Steve Cuss facilitated by Tom Hinsman
Do you believe God loves you and is with you – but sometimes you don't feel it? Or maybe you've thought you'd be further along in your spiritual journey with Christ by now! When what we expect and believe about God doesn't align with what we actually experience in everyday life, we're left with a gap – sometimes filled with doubt, shame, or fear. Steve Cuss helps us identify those gaps, confront the unhelpful stories we tell ourselves, and discover the peace that comes from trusting God's word, His presence and His work in our lives.

Month of July Topic

The Book of Philemon by Jeyakaran Emmanuel facilitated by Bill Johnson.

The book of Philemon may be one of the shortest books in the New Testament, yet it offers a compelling portrait of the gospel at work in everyday life. In it the Apostle Paul sends a runaway slave that has become a Christian back to his master. The study of this book reveals grace in action showing how the good news of Jesus reshapes power, redefines identity, and makes reconciliation possible. It shows how the gospel transforms relationships and forms a new kind of community rooted in love and restored fellowship.

Month of August Topic

Unlikely Candidates by Koketso Molaolwe facilitated by Steve DeBettignies

'Sorry, God, you've got the wrong person. I can't do that.' We often look at our lives – our upbringing, education (or lack thereof), our fears, flaws and insecurities – and decide God can't possibly use us to impact the world. But this inspiring four-part series reminds us that where we see insignificance, God sees potential. What we dismiss as too ordinary, God calls the perfect place to reveal His extraordinary power.

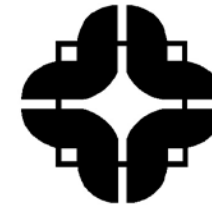
