## The Epistle

**Romans 1:1-17**

Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God, which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy scriptures, the gospel concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh and was declared to be Son of God with power according to the spirit of holiness by resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord, through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith among all the Gentiles for the sake of his name, including yourselves who are called to belong to Jesus Christ,

To all God's beloved in Rome, who are called to be saints:

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed throughout the world. For God, whom I serve with my spirit by announcing the gospel of his Son, is my witness that without ceasing I remember you always in my prayers, asking

that by God's will I may somehow at last succeed in coming to you. For I am longing to see you so that I may share with you some spiritual gift to strengthen you - or rather so that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine. I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that I have often intended to come to you (but thus far have been prevented), in order that I may reap some harvest among you as I have among the rest of the Gentiles. I am a debtor both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish - hence my eagerness to proclaim the gospel to you also who are in Rome. For I am not ashamed of the gospel; it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed through faith for faith; as it is written, "The one who is righteous will live by faith."

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

# Holy Baptism

## The Presentation and Examination of the Candidate

Celebrant: The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

*Parents & Godparents:*

*I present Brielle Louise to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.*

Celebrant *(to Parents & Godparents):*

Will you be responsible for seeing that this child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

*Parents & Godparents:*

*I will, with God's help.*

Celebrant: Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?

*Parents & Godparents:*

*I will, with God's help.*

*Then the Celebrant asks the following questions of the parents and godparents who speak on behalf of the child.*

Celebrant: Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

*Answer* *I renounce them.*

Celebrant: Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

*Answer* *I renounce them.*

Celebrant: Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

*Answer* *I renounce them.*

Celebrant: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior?

*Answer* *I do.*

Celebrant: Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?

*Answer* *I do.*

Celebrant: Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord?

*Answer* *I do.*

*Then the Celebrant addresses the congregation.*

Celebrant: Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support this person in her life in Christ?

**All: We will.**

Celebrant: Let us join with those who are committing Brielle and themselves to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

## **The Baptismal Covenant**

Celebrant: Do you believe in God the Father?

**All: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

Celebrant: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

**All: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.**

Celebrant: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

**All: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.**

Celebrant: Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers?

**All: I will, with God's help.**

Celebrant: Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?

**All: I will, with God's help.**

Celebrant: Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ?

**All: I will, with God's help.**

Celebrant: Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

**All: I will, with God's help.**

Celebrant: Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

**All: I will, with God's help.**

### **Prayers for the Candidate**

Celebrant: Let us now pray for Brielle who is to receive the Sacrament of new birth.

Leader: Deliver her, O Lord, from the way of sin and death.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: Open her heart to your grace and truth.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: Fill her with your holy and life-giving Spirit.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: Keep her in the faith and communion of your holy Church.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: Teach her to love others in the power of the Spirit.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: Send her into the world in witness to your love.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: Bring her to the fullness of your peace and glory.

**All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Celebrant: Grant, O Lord, that all who are baptized into the death of Jesus Christ your Son may live in the power of his resurrection and look for him to come again in glory; who lives and reigns now and forever. **Amen.**

### **Thanksgiving over the Water**

*The Celebrant blesses the water, first saying:*

The Lord be with you.

**All: And also with you.**

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**All: It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

Celebrant: We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

*At the following words, the Celebrant touches the water.*

Now sanctify this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those who here are cleansed from sin and born again may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior.

To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. **Amen.**

## The Baptism

*The candidate is presented by name to the Celebrant who pours water upon the candidate, saying:*

Celebrant: Brielle Louise, I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

*When this action has been completed, the Celebrant, at a place in full sight of the congregation, prays over her, saying:*

Celebrant: Let us pray. Heavenly Father, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon this your servant the forgiveness of sin, and have raised her to the new life of grace. Sustain her, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give her an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works. **Amen.**

*Then the Celebrant places a hand on the candidate's head, marking on the forehead the sign of the cross and saying:*

Celebrant: Brielle Louise, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own for ever. **Amen.**

## Baptism Candle Presentation

Celebrant: Walk in the faith of Christ crucified and risen. Shine with the light of Christ.

Celebrant: Let us welcome the newly baptized.

**All: We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.**

## THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

**People: And also with you.**

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts.

**People: We lift them to the Lord.**

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**People: It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

Celebrant: It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, for your wisdom, once secret and hidden, has been revealed to us by the light of your Christ and the gift of your Holy Spirit. What once no eye had seen, nor ear heard, nor the human heart conceived, you, O Lord, have made know to those who love you.

Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with Angels and Archangels, and with all the company of heaven, who forever sing this hymn to proclaim the glory of your Name:

Celebrant Holy and gracious Father: We give you thanks for Jesus Christ, who for us and for our salvation became obedient unto death.

On the night he was betrayed he took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat: This is my Body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

After supper he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood of the new Covenant, shed for you and for many. Do this in remembrance of me."

Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

**All: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**

We offer this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, and we pray that by your Holy Spirit it may be for us the Body and Blood of Christ. Grant that we, burning with your Spirit's power, may be a people of love and justice, making all things new in Christ.

### **The Lord's Prayer**

Celebrant: And now, as our Savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to say,

**All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.**

**The Breaking of the Bread** A brief silence is kept.

Celebrant: Alleluia. Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us;

**All: Therefore let us keep the feast. Alleluia.**

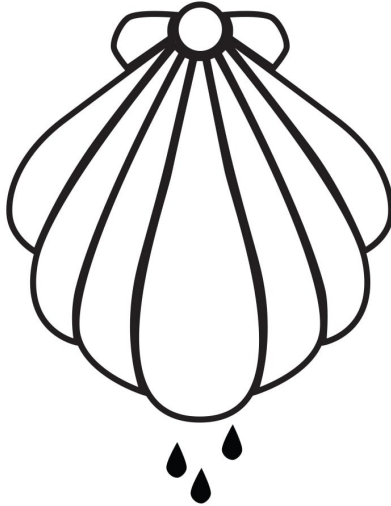
