BIG IDEA: Greatness in God's kingdom is revealed through humility, holiness, and selfless love.

TRUE GREATNESS IS FOUND IN HUMBLE SERVICE (vv. 30-37)

Kingdom greatness is not about prominence but about serving others with humility.

Jesus measures greatness by how we treat the overlooked and insignificant.

TRUE DISCIPLES VALUE KINGDOM WORK OVER PERSONAL STATUS (vv. 38-41)

Jesus' kingdom is bigger than our spheres and platforms.

A kingdom mindset celebrates every genuine work done in Jesus' name.

TRUE DISCIPLES TAKE SIN SERIOUSLY (vv. 42-48)

Discipleship demands wholehearted holiness and waging war against sin.

Sin never stays small—it has eternal consequences.

TRUE DISCIPLES LIVE AS PEOPLE OF PEACE AND PURITY (vv. 49-50)

Followers of Jesus are refined by sacrifice and marked by peace.

Disciples are called to influence the world without losing their distinctiveness.
