Sermon Text: **Matt 28:16-20 & Jn 17:1-5, 20-26**

Key Ideas from the Sermon:

- Jesus reveals that there is one God in 3 persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- God is Love: eternally existing in relationships of love and glory.
- Being made in God's image, we are created by love and for love.
- Jesus' commands us to love others as he has loved us – to love is to be most like God.
- We can be tempted to limit our love and compassion for others. Without abandoning wisdom, Jesus calls us to love others as he has loved us.

• Bible Study: The Swedish Method [**John 17:1-26**]

1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for and taking note of the following four things:



Lightbulb: This should be something that 'shines' from the passage- whatever impacts most, or draws attention.

Question mark: Anything that is difficult to understand in the text, or a question the reader might like to ask the writer of the passage, or the Lord.
