Togo Prayer Trip 2026

We arrived home from Togo late last night and had a good night of rest in our own bed. I woke up around 4 am which would have been 9 am in Togo, so I felt like I slept in! The previous day we were up at 6, out the guest house door by 6:45 and then on our way to our final day with our global workers and Togolese Pastors and their wives at a Pastor's conference. We were privileged to hear some awesome teaching (through an interpreter) and take part in the beautiful, celebratory worship with our Togolese brothers and sisters. Just before we had to leave to get back to the guest house to pack up and head to the airport, and as we said our goodbyes, the whole group gathered around our team of 12 and prayed over us. How incredibly humbling for us to have them, who we pray for daily, cry out to God in many different languages, on our behalf!

So, after a full day followed by about 19 hours of flying and airport time, customs, baggage and passport inspection, exit forms, etc, and then the 5 hour drive home from Minneapolis, we are home. By now (mid-afternoon) our laundry is washed and put away, the suitcases are back in the closet, the lawn is mowed and we are physically unpacked. But to truly UNPACK all that we experienced in Togo, will take much, much longer. There is no quick one or two sentence answer to the question, "How was your trip?" Over the next days and weeks, please be patient with us if it seems like all we can talk about is Togo. It will literally just bubble out and overflow from our hearts. The transition from an earthy, raw, steamy, lush and communal culture back to our often cluttered, manufactured and transactional world is difficult, but we remain incredibly grateful and humbled that God allowed us the privilege of being a part of something God-sized that is happening in Togo! Thank you for standing with us in prayer, and believing for more than we can see right now. We're grateful for every prayer, every moment and every heart that joined in! We're just getting started!
