A special congregational meeting will be held on
Sunday, June 21,

immediately following the morning worship service.

At last February’s annual church meeting, the congregation approved a motion to engage ABCE Professional Chartered Accountants to perform our 2026 audit. Since that time, the Board of Directors has recommended our church move from the traditional annual financial Audit to what is called a Review

Engagement. The Session has endorsed the board recommendation. Congregational approval is needed to make such a change.

The chair of the Board of Trustees, Ken Heckbert, who is a Chartered Professional Accountant, will be on hand on June 21 to explain, and answer, any questions congregation members may have regarding the proposed change to a Review Engagement
