Cadet Camporee Fundraising Update

We are 5 weeks away from the International Cadet Camporee in Longview Alberta!! From our church alone, we have 21 people attending. 4 Counselors, 1 Chaplain, 2 Staff Members, and 14 Cadets. Throughout this cadet season, we have had 3 different fundraisers. Our goal was to raise \$11,000 to cover the registration, travel cost and counselor supplies for all attendees to the camporee. After 3 fundraisers, we have raised \$5157.00 (not including a \$2000 donation check received from a non-Christian parent of a cadet). This means that our fundraisers have raised 46% of our target. With the addition of the \$2000 donation we are at 65% of our total target. The Cadet Camporee is a deeply impactful event in a cadets career, one that deepens their brotherhood with other cadets and counselors, and encourages them to continue in their faithful walk with Christ. Friendships are formed across North America, friendships that last long into adulthood. We are asking for congregational help for the remaining \$3800.00 to hit our target. \$11,000 will cover the cost, but not provide much extra for supplies and camping upgrades. Please pray about this request, and if you feel that donating to this ministry has been pressed on your heart, you can E-Transfer the Cadet Ministry at leduccadets@gmail.com. Please specify in the subject line that your donation is for the Camporee. Any money received over and above what is needed for this Camporee will be held to help with expenses for the 2029 Camporee in Pella, Iowa.
