

Frequently Asked Questions

General Information

What is the preschool's value's? **Our values- As members of the Family of God, we share our faith and joy in Christ by nurturing the spiritual, physical, emotional, social, language, and cognitive needs of each unique child of God in a safe, healthy, and loving environment.**

What is the preschool's curriculum? **Our curriculum is designed with the whole child in mind. Activities are based on developmentally age-appropriate practices. WeeSchool uses additional curriculum resources such as Handwriting Without Tears, Circle PreK curriculum- CLI Engage, and are aware of Texas Prekindergarten Guidelines to assist in planning quality classroom experiences.**

What are the age requirements for enrollment? **18mos-5years as of September 1**

What is the teacher-to-student ratio?

Toddlers- Zebra Class 2:9

Twos- Monkey and Giraffe Class 2:10

Threes- Hippo and Lion Class 2:15

Prek (fours)- Bear Class 2:15, Turtle Class 2:14, Rabbit Class 2:12

What are the preschool's hours of operation? **8:30am-2pm** Are there options for extended care? **No**

Is the preschool a State Licensed Child Care? **Yes.**

Daily Operations

What does a typical daily schedule look like? **The day includes opportunities to develop while playing and moving, Bible time, snack, lunch, outdoor breaks, music/movement, individual and group experiences, a balance of teacher and child led activities, independence and time for rest.**

What supplies does my child need? **Every child arrives daily with a backpack (that can fit a vinyl folder), snack, lunch, water bottle, change of clothes and nap mat. Diapers, if applicable.**

How do you handle discipline? **WeeSchool understands that little learners need patience, redirection and positive reinforcement, and help to self-regulate from adults. Teachers will not use corporal punishment or withhold food or any outdoor play time.**

Does the school provide meals? **No. The parents are responsible for sending one snack. A lunch and a thermos for water only.**

Staff and Training

What qualifications and training do the teachers and staff have? **Staff are CPR/FA certified. Staff are required to complete at least 24 hours of annual training. Director must complete at least 30 hours of annual training.**

Health and Safety

What security measures are in place to ensure the safety of the children? **Exterior doors are locked during the school day. WeeSchool staff complete a background check/ fingerprints. Church staff are background checked through Ministry Safe. Fire, severe weather and lockdown drills are practiced regularly. WeeSchool maintains cleaning habits to minimize spread of viruses and bacteria.**
