

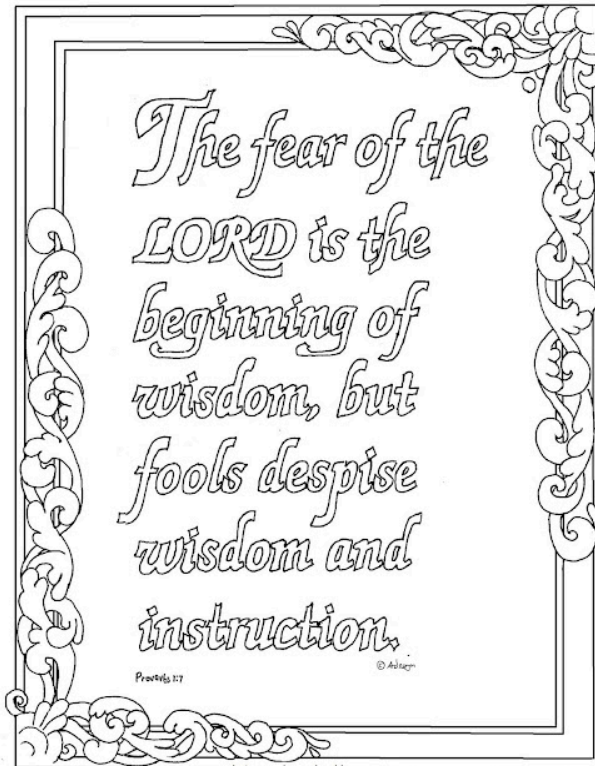

CHOOSE WISDOM

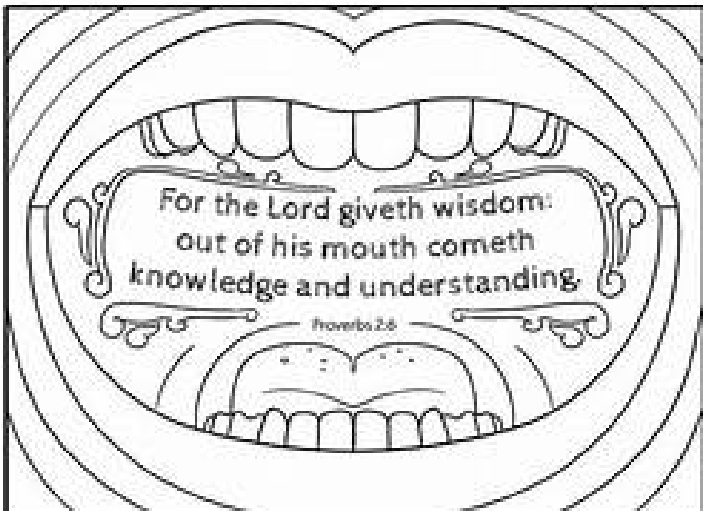

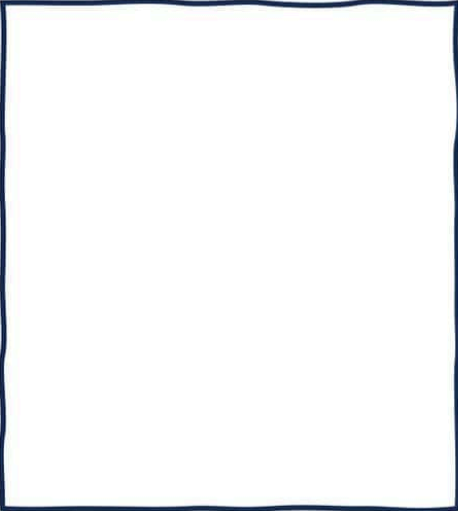
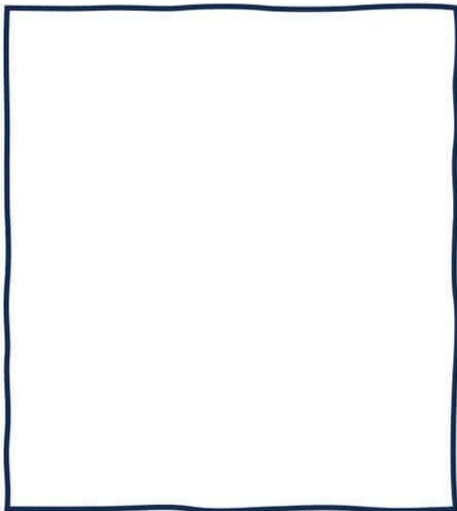
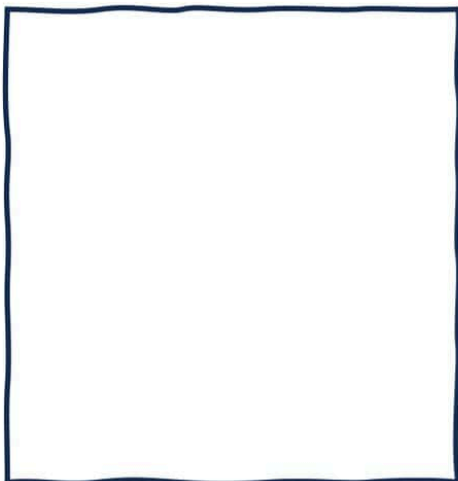
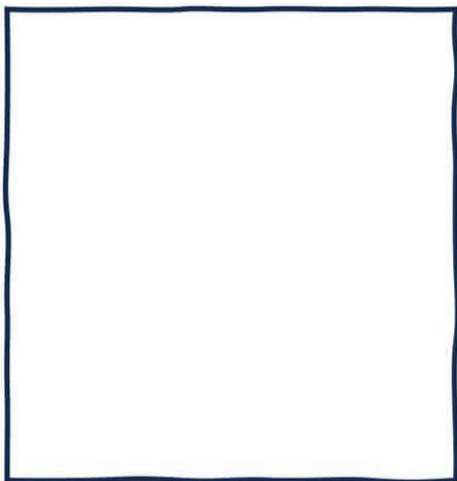


DRAW THE PROVERB

Read some proverbs and draw a scene or symbol in the space provided to represent it.

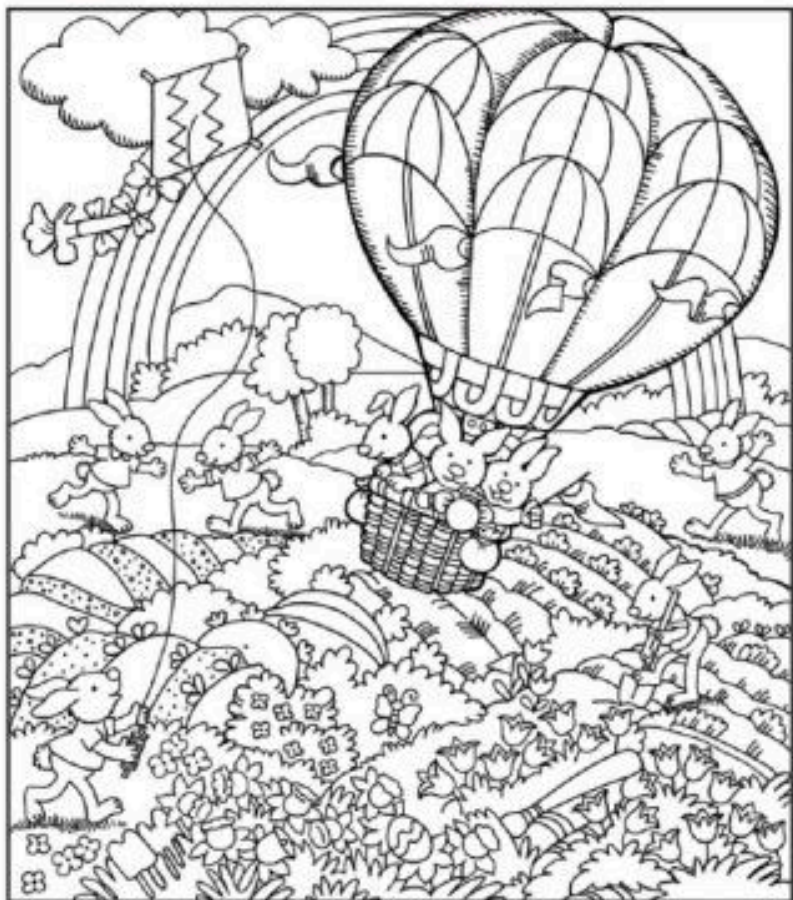
Here are some ideas:

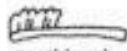

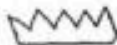
