And I sighed,

On June 5, 2023, three years ago, a moving van full of my stuff pulled up to the driveway at the parsonage on Britannica Drive. I'd already spent my first night in the house, on an air mattress on the floor, so that I would be ready when the movers arrived in the morning. I didn't know what the coming years would bring, and neither did you, but I knew we would walk into them together.

Abundantly far more than anything I could ask or imagine—that's what I continue to experience as we do ministry together here in Huntington, and I'm delighted that Bishop Malone has appointed me to serve Huntington Trinity for another year. That appointment will be officially set at Annual Conference on June 6th and we will begin our fourth year together on July 1. While I have no way to guarantee or predict how long my tenure at Trinity will be, I hope to serve with you for many years to come, so long as our ministry together continues to be healthy and fruitful!

I want to thank you all for your prayers and support these past three years, and for the many different ways you each answer the call God has placed on your life just as I continue to answer the call God has placed on mine. Sharing ministry with you and working in partnership with the many gifts and talents God has given all of you is a big part of what makes serving as the pastor of Trinity such a delightful and rewarding experience. Keep praying! Keep listening for God's voice! Keep watching for open doors! Keep answering God's call; because God doesn't just call pastors, God calls us all!

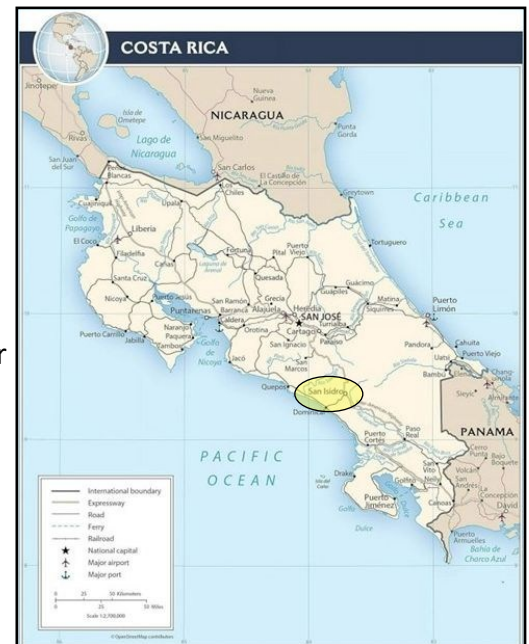

SECOND MILE GIVING FOR JUNE– HARMONY HOME

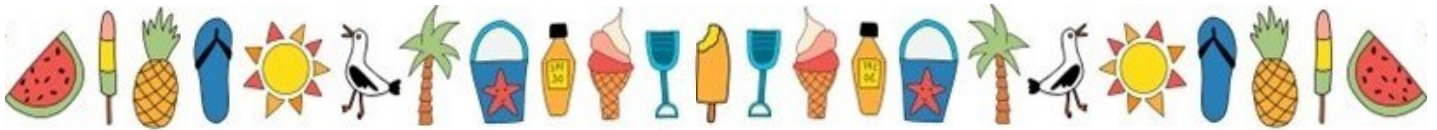

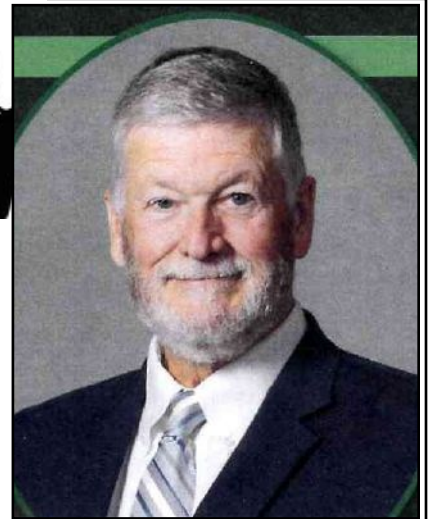

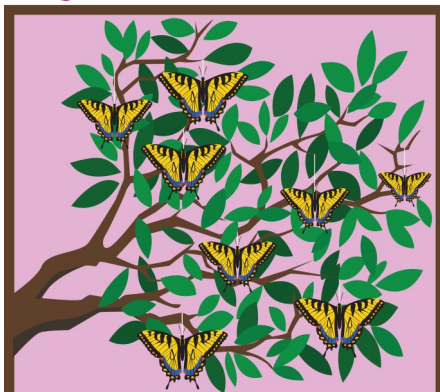
