2 Peter 1:1-7 | June 7, 2026

1. What's something you've purchased that turned out to be much more valuable than you expected? What's something that wasn't worth it at all?
2. Read 2 Peter 1:1-7 and review the sermon outline. What stood out to you most from Sunday's message? Why do you think it caught your attention?
3. Peter says we have "received" faith (v. 1). Why do you think it's important to remember that faith is something we receive from God rather than something we manufacture ourselves?
4. Where in your life are you treating your faith as something you achieved rather than something you received? How does that subtle shift affect your prayer, your worship, your sense of pressure?
5. Peter described our faith as precious. What are some ways believers can unintentionally take their faith for granted? What helps keep your appreciation for it fresh?
6. Peter begins the list of spiritual qualities in verse 5 with faith. Why do you think faith comes first? What happens when we focus on spiritual growth while losing sight of faith itself?
7. The sermon depicted your faith as the most valuable item in your spiritual shopping cart. What are some things that compete for the top spot in your attention, affection, or trust?
8. If a friend asked you, "How is your faith growing?," what would be your honest answer?
