First off, we are hosting Vacation Bible School June 14-18, 5:30 – 8:00. A huge thank you to Audra for stepping up to be the director of VBS this year. I love VBS! What an amazing week of fun and missions and Bible study! VBS is an annual opportunity to expose dozens of kids to the Gospel of Jesus!

Another reason that June is a big month for our children's ministry is that we are getting really close to hiring our next Children's Minister. We have had over a dozen resumes submitted, 3 that made the list and 1 is the top candidate that we are pursuing. We are praying for God to lead us to the perfect candidate because this ministry is crucial to us reaching the neighborhoods around us in South Greenville.

We have chosen to make this position a full-time position. How? You may ask. The new children's minister will begin a new ministry next year called CAMP REEDY FORK. Camp Reedy Fork is an after-school care/Summer Camp hosted at the church. We will register up to 25 kids and pick them up from school. Once here, they will get homework assistance, snack, games, and Bible study. This program will bring in enough revenue to supplement the church budget to make our children's minister full-time.

I will give more information and answer questions at the next business meeting in the Summer.
