Prior to the time when the Reformation really started, the Scriptures were not translated into the peoples' _____.

During this time the Bible was predominately in Latin, and people had no idea what it said.

And that's just like it was in the Lord's time because the Scripture then was in Hebrew and most Jews had very little knowledge of Hebrew; they spoke _____.

And since the Jews didn't understand the Scriptures, the rabbis' built an entire system based upon the ignorance of the people regarding the Hebrew text.
