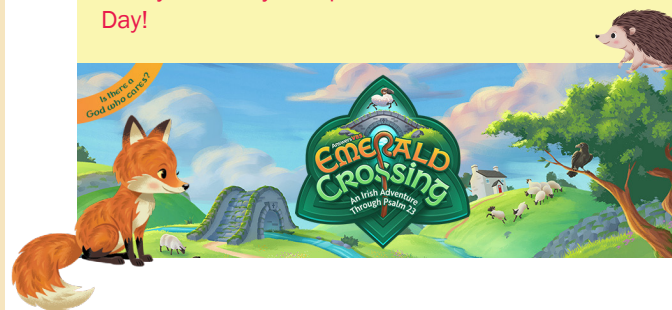
### VBS Preview Day: Find out what VBS is all about on Sunday, June 21, 9:00-10:30 AM

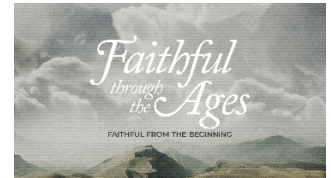

# Faithful through the Ages

## FAITHFUL FROM THE BEGINNING

Next Steps: Home-Group Study and/or Personal Discipleship Guide

John 1:1-3, Col.

1:15-17, Heb.

11:3, Gen. 3:15

Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!

**Start with Prayer:** Ask Jesus to guide our time together. Review prayer requests.

**Anchor Question:** Since Jesus is faithful from the beginning, what does this reveal about His posture toward us now?

**Read the text** (or portions) from 2 different versions –

*Jn. 1:1-3, Col. 1:15-17, Heb. 11:3, Gen. 3:15*

Pauses for Reflection and Discussion –

1. “There is deep mercy in learning that we are not the ones holding our universe together.”
  - *Where are we carrying something that only Christ can truly hold?*
2. “In him all things hold together.” – Colossians 1:17
  - *How does this speak to places in our lives that feel unstable, uncertain, or fragile?*
3. “Creation has a source...a center...and a sustainer. His name is Jesus.”
  - *What changes in our lives when we see Jesus not only as our Savior and Lord, but also as the One who is before and over all things?*
4. “The lie is ancient, but its language is still fluent.”
  - *Where do we still hear the old lie that God cannot really be trusted?*
5. “The first movement after human rebellion is not humanity searching for God. It is God searching for humanity.”
  - *What does God’s question, “Where are you?” reveal about His heart toward people who are living in shame and hiding?*
6. “God creates. Humanity breaks. God moves toward us with a promise.”
  - *How does this pattern help us understand the faithfulness of Jesus from the beginning?*
7. “His posture toward us is mercy. His movement toward us is grace. His presence with us is steady.”
  - *Where do we need to receive the mercy, nearness, forgiveness, or lordship of Jesus today?*
