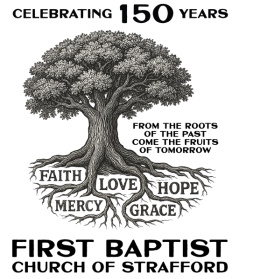

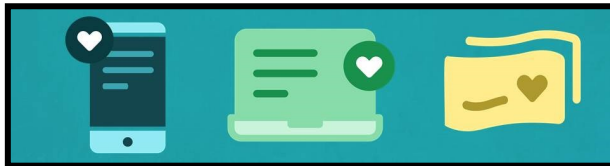


Welcome, Guests!
