The pictures are of our recent DVBS. The motorcycle has 11 children plus the driver. They came from over 7 km back and forth. The cost was little over \$6 back and forth.

It is summertime here and very hot. Too hot to visit sometimes. During the month of May the children are taken to the Catholic church for catechism classes. The Philippines is 87% Catholic. We have the first Baptist church in the 26 towns in N. Samar. There are now 18 churches started in N. Samar. Please pray for these towns that do not have a Baptist church as yet; Silvino Lubos, Allen, Capul, Victoria, San Antonio and Biri.

There have been 10 new Bible college students that have moved into the dorms. We are expecting several more. Please pray for more boys. We have plenty of girls. The staff and students have been busy soul winning and looking for new students in other towns.

The Lighthouse 104.5 FM station is still on the air 24 hours a day. Pray we can get the new 3000 watt transmitter hooked up.

Please pray for Pastor Renato Tumandao. He is 61 year old and retired army. He started a church in Dulag, Leyte. He is in the military hospital in Manila with stomach pain.

Our Pentecost Sunday will be on June 28 in Freedom Park. Please pray that we can extend our church auditorium to accommodate Big Days. Thank you ever so much for your giving in prayers and finances.

We will be in the States in March 2027, Lord willing, for check-ups. Let us know if you would like us to report on the work here.
