It is done! After almost a decade of leading the “Maion de la Solidarité” as its president and having served on the board for over two decades, Marc stepped down on March 21. A lot of hard work went into finding the right solution. Many people were rather anxious about what would be next. An idea was proposed: merging with our partner organization, responsible for the food distribution, and putting in place a team of 5 co-directors sharing the responsibilities, instead of 1 president who has all the responsibilities. We had different meetings throughout the winter to make sure we were all on board and that the various apprehensions were dealt with. Marc had to write up the merger project with all its particulars, as well as the new statutes. It was very energy consuming, but it is done. It made for three articles in the regional newspaper *La Nouvelle République*.

Unfortunately, one of the five co-directors lost his cool and left his post, not even lasting three weeks! That’s reality for you! Now, Marc is helping the leadership team as an “outsider” to help them through the challenge.

Finding competent people who are willing to accept responsibilities and who will persevere in the job, let alone finding the *right* people, is a real challenge. Many organizations in France struggle to find leaders.

With five churches under his responsibilities, Marc is confronted with the need to train people. But finding faithful, available, and teachable people is a rare gift. Indeed, it is a matter for praying to the Master of the harvest. And yet, there are people, like Anjara, a PA teacher in his 30s who is being trained for ministry. He just finished his first cycle and is going to do his internship in our church where he and his wife have been a part. Pray for them, that they grow in strength and in wisdom.
