June Series: Live What Was Built

Week Focus: Wear What Was Built

Scripture – Colossians 3:12–14 “As God’s chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Above all, put on love.”

Devotional Reflection

As we conclude this week’s journey, take a moment to reflect on what God has been teaching you about identity, character, and transformation. Throughout the week, you were reminded that before God calls you to live differently, He first reminds you who you are. You are chosen. You are holy. You are dearly loved. These truths are not goals to achieve; they are realities to embrace. Everything God desires to build through you begins with understanding what He has already established within you.

This week also revealed that the Christian life is not about pretending to be someone you are not. It is about consistently living from the identity God has given you through Christ. Compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, forgiveness, and love are not qualities we manufacture through willpower alone. They are evidence of God’s ongoing work in a surrendered heart. The more we remain connected to Him, the more His character becomes visible in our lives.

Perhaps God has shown you areas where growth is taking place. Maybe you have responded differently to a difficult situation. Perhaps you have extended forgiveness where bitterness once existed. Maybe you have become more patient, more gracious, or more aware of the needs of others. These moments may seem small, but they are significant signs that transformation is happening. Spiritual maturity is often revealed not in dramatic moments but in consistent daily choices that reflect the character of Christ.

You may also recognize areas where God is still stretching and refining you. That realization should not discourage you. Growth is a lifelong process. The same God who began a good work in you remains committed to completing it. Every challenge becomes an opportunity to wear what He has built. Every relationship becomes an opportunity to display His character. Every day becomes another chance to reflect Christ more clearly.

As you prepare for a new week, carry this truth with you: God did not simply save you from something; He is shaping you into someone. The life He is building within you is meant to be seen. When you walk in compassion, kindness, humility, forgiveness, and love, you are wearing what God has built. Let the world see the evidence of His transforming work in your life.

Focus for Today

Because I am chosen, loved, and transformed by God, I will wear His character in my daily life.

Weekly Reflection

Take a few moments to prayerfully consider:

- What truth about my identity in Christ impacted me most this week?
 - Where have I seen evidence of God's transformation in my life?
 - Is there someone I need to forgive or love more intentionally?
 - Which Christlike quality do I want God to strengthen in me this coming week?
 - How can I better reflect Christ in my daily interactions?
