Food for Thought

1. What does Paul accomplish through his trials and defenses? What does it look like to be a witness of Christ, and how does Paul's example teach us about witnessing Him in all circumstances?
2. In the five defenses Paul gives in Acts 21-26 his argument stays consistent. That the gospel is rooted in historical evidence, personal transformation, and biblical fulfillment. Of the appeals Paul gives, which do you find the most compelling and why? How do these appeals speak to the kinds of questions people have today?
3. How does knowing the crucified and risen Christ give Paul the boldness to testify to the kings and ruling authorities whilst in chains? Where do you think Christians struggle most to be bold and how can the Gospel speak into these struggles?
