DIGGING DEEPER

Questions To Guide Further Study:

1. How does the “good news” described in Isaiah 52:7 reshape your understanding of what God’s salvation meant for Israel—and what it means for you today?
2. Why does Isaiah emphasize the *beauty* of the messenger’s feet, and what does that reveal about the nature of God’s message?
3. Why are *peace*, *good tidings*, and *salvation* grouped together, and what does that reveal about the nature of God’s deliverance?
4. How does this verse shape the New Testament understanding of evangelism and mission?
5. **Personal application** – In what ways are you called to be a bearer of good news in your own community?

Weekly Challenge:

Becoming a messenger who brings peace, good news, and the reality that
“*Your God reigns.*”

1. Share one encouraging truth with someone each day this week. This mirrors the verse’s emphasis on “*bringing good tidings*”—news that lifts burdens and restores.
2. Identify one relationship, conversation, or environment where you can actively bring peace.
3. Name one “mountain” (obstacle, fear, or difficult place) that keeps you from sharing goodness—and take one concrete step up that mountain.
4. Choose one daily habit that visibly reflects the truth “*Your God reigns.*” This could be practicing gratitude, resisting worry, or acting with integrity in a difficult moment.

THE BIG IDEA

The “beautiful feet” symbolize the value of the message, not the messenger.
